

## **Goal**

To help coordinate the pigeon guillemot breeding surveys along the Strait of Juan de Fuca and to help ensure that the data is entered into designated databases.

## **General Overview**

One intern will participate in the 2019 MRC's Pigeon Guillemot breeding surveys. The intern will be paired with an MRC mentor who will oversee and assist the intern in the completion of the project tasks.

The intern will be allocated 80 billable hours to be used as needed to complete the project tasks and will provide a time card to Helle Andersen twice a month for reimbursement.

Whenever possible the intern will attend the weekly intern meeting that is held in the Port Angeles and will be expected to report on the activities of the previous week. The meetings are intended to provide the MRC mentor with an update of the progress being made and allow the interns to interact with the other interns who are working on different MRC projects.

## **Tasks**

- Help organize and communicate with the volunteers throughout the survey season
- Assist the MRC mentor with entering weekly field data sheets into designated databases and/or help volunteers enter their own data electronically
- Participate in at least two survey events
- Prepare a presentation of what you accomplished and what you learned during your internship to be given by you at the Intern Celebration at the end of summer.
